

FABRIC CLEANING CARE CODES

Match the care instructions below with the fabric cleaning codes.
Professional cleaning is always recommended.

S Frequent vacuuming or light brushing to remove dust and grime recommended.
Spot clean with mild water-free solvent or dry cleaning product.

SW Spot clean with upholstery shampoo, foam from a mild detergent, or mild dry cleaning solvent.
Do not saturate. Pile fabrics may require brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to restore appearance.
Hot water extraction or steam cleaning is not recommended.

W Use a water-based upholstery cleaner only.

WS Frequent vacuuming or light brushing to remove dust and grime recommended.
Spot clean with mild solvent, upholstery shampoo, or foam from a mild detergent.

LEATHER CARE

Our Aniline-dyed Leather has been treated to enhance stain resistance. It is more uniform in color and texture than other leathers and will have fewer noticeable range markings. Keep leather clean by dusting frequently with a soft, clean cloth or by vacuuming with a soft brush attachment. Aniline-dyed leather will lighten and soften with both use and time and develop a rich, burnished patina. Avoid direct sunlight and heat to prevent premature fading. Do not use polishes, preservers or leather soaps. Light scratches may be rubbed out by the natural heat of a finger, but some distressing natural with age.
