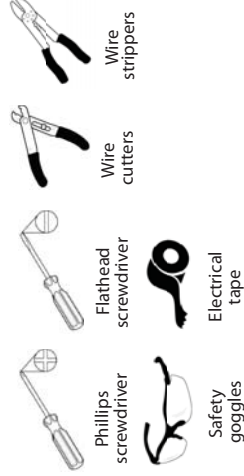


## Installation

**⚠ DANGER:** Before installation, turn off the main power at the circuit breaker.

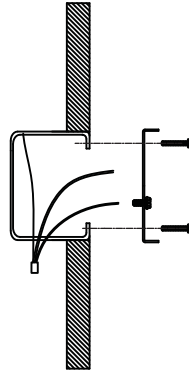
**⚠ WARNING:** Installation must be performed by a qualified licensed electrician.

### TOOLS REQUIRED FOR INSTALLATION AND ASSEMBLY (not included):



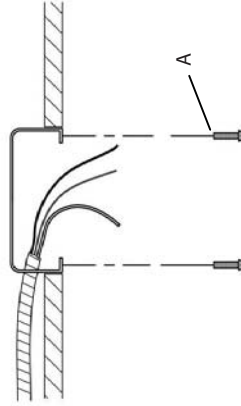
## 1 Removing the existing fixture

- A. Remove the existing fixture.



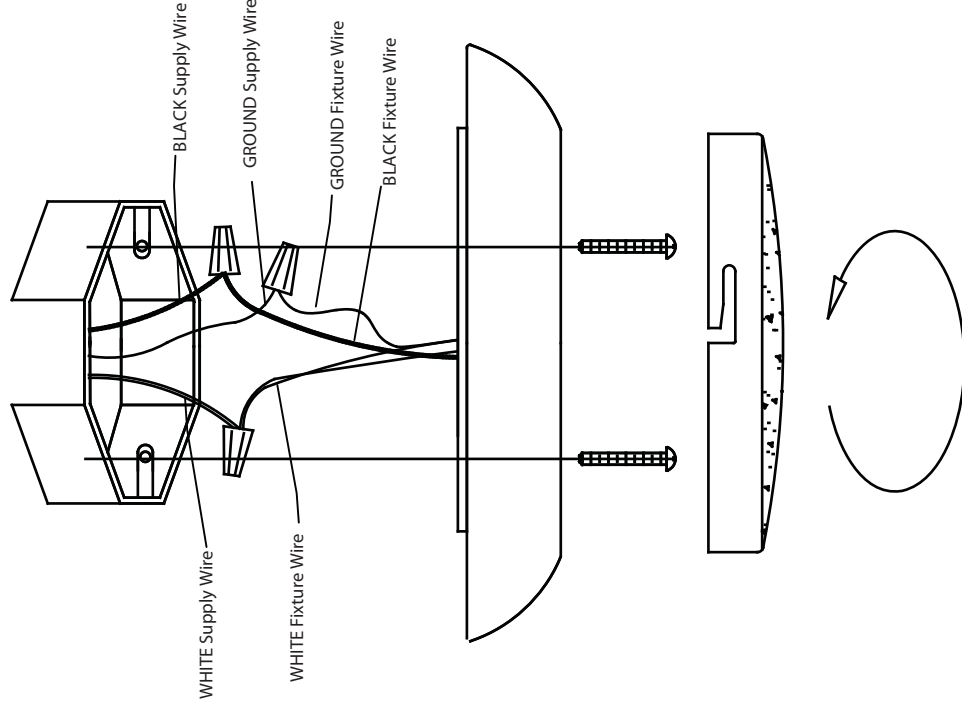
## 2 Install Fixture Mounting Screws

- A. Install fixture mounting screws (A)



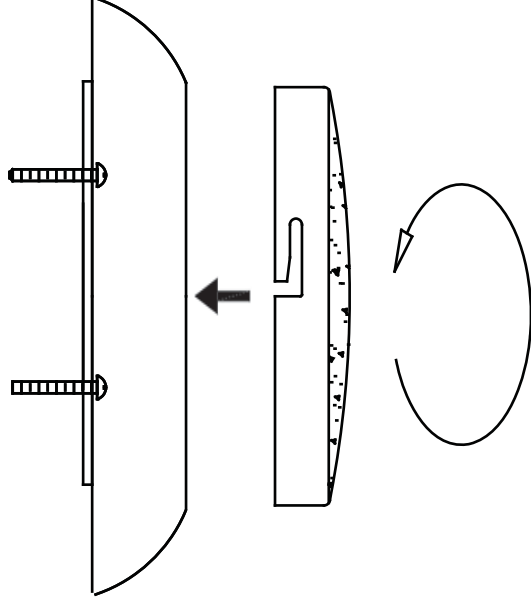
## 3 Connecting the wires

- A. Connect the white supply wire to the white fixture wire.
- B. Connect the black supply wire to the black fixture wire.
- C. Connect the ground supply wire to the ground fixture wire.
- D. Use wire nuts to secure all connections.



## 4 Installing the ceiling fixture

- A. Install the fixture base onto fixture screws and secure by turning clockwise into slots.
- B. Tighten fixture housing screws. Do not over tighten.
- C. Install the Lens inside the fixture and turn clockwise. Hand tighten only. Do not over tighten.
