



OPERATING YOUR LIFT CHAIR



How to use the Heat and Massage function.

- Press the MASSAGE button once to activate the massage function. The massage is automatically set to the WAVE setting.
- Press the MASSAGE button again to go to the next of the three available massage settings: WAVE, STEADY, or PULSE. Each press of the button will take you to the next setting. Each setting is indicated by a COLORED LED light.
- Press and hold the MASSAGE button for approximately 2 seconds to shut the massage function OFF, other wise the massage function will automatically shut off after 20 minutes of continuous use.

How to adjust the intensity of the massage function.

- Press the INTENSITY button once to set the massage intensity to LOW.
- Press the INTENSITY button again to set the massage intensity to the next of three available settings: LOW, MEDIUM or HIGH. Each press of the button will take you to the next setting. Each setting is indicated by a COLORED LED light.

NOTE: All heat units are designed with an auto-shutoff mechanism that turns off the heater after 20 minutes of use. It is recommended the heat and massage units not be used for more than 20 minutes at a time. However, you should consult your physician about how often you should use the heat and massage options of our lift.


FABRIC CARE INSTRUCTIONS

The micro suede fabric covering this specific piece of furniture is soft to the touch and very durable for every day living. It is recommended by the fabric manufacturer to only clean this type of fabric with water-based cleaning agents or foam. Lightly scrubbing the fabric will help with any tougher spots that may have developed. Always check a spot of fabric in an area that is unseen to be sure the cleaning agent being used will not discolor or fade the fabric's finish. Let air dry and vacuum for best results.

CORD AND TRANSFORMER CONNECTIONS

Once the box has been removed from around the chair, you'll notice the back is laying on top of the seat. There are a couple items to remove from the seat portion of the chair first. Follow the steps below:

- 1. The transformer and the power cable are in a foam bag located on top of the chair. Connect to the plug coming from the seat.
- 2. Control Wand is located in pocket on the outside of the chair as shown in Figure A.
- 3. Slide the back down on the base. The back receiver brackets slide down on the mechanism arms coming up. See Figure B.
- 4. Connect the massage unit from the back to the plug marked BACK.
- 5. Connect the heat unit from the back to the plug marked HEAT.





Press and hold the UP button to raise your lift chair to the standing position. Back into the lift chair and sit in the center of the seat, using the armrests for

Press the DOWN button to lower the lift chair to a comfortable seated position.

Press and hold the DOWN button until comfortably reclined.

Press and hold the UP button to return to an upright position. Release the button when the lift chair reaches a comfortable seated position.

Press and hold the UP button to raise your lift chair.

Release the button when the lift chair reaches a height where you can stand

Press and hold the LOCK button for approximately 3 seconds to lock the hand control. The RED LED to the right of the button will light up to indicate the hand

Press and hold the LOCK button for approximately 6 second to unlock the hand control. The GREEN LED to the left of the button will light up to indicate the hand
