

Congratulations with your *French Connections* furniture.

This model are produced by certified beech wood and MDF, the wood has been oven dried, to reduce the risk of cracks in the joints.

For cleaning the furniture, we recommend warm water and a gentle cleanser for wooden furniture.

Important information about humidity

All wood is oven-dried down to 10%-12% wood humidity, this corresponding to a humidity of 40% at 20 degrees. The wood working more or less, depending on the humidity of the surroundings. It has the property that it will take up or give off moisture, depending on the surroundings the furniture are in. The tree expands therefore in humid periods and will contract during dry periods. This means that the wood can contract in the joints, which will be visible on a painted furniture. When the wood then expands again, the paint will unfortunately not follow in place, then the cracked paint in the joints will remain there.

The heating of apartments and houses today (fact), is airtight, this means that the humidity often come demanded down.

In humans, we feel it by dry mucous membranes and on our wood furniture can cause fissures and cracks, which are a natural consequence of fluctuating humidity.

It's always a good idea to ensure that the right humidity in the home. This can easily be done with a hygrometer - The relative humidity indoors should be in the range of 30-60%
