- This crib conforms to applicable regulations promulgated by the Consumer Products Safety Commission.
- To reduce the risk of SIDS, pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.
- DO NOT use a water mattress with this crib.
- If refinishing, use a non-toxic finish specified for children's products.
- Check fasteners periodically and never over tighten then, as this may cause distortion or breakage.
- Never use plastic shipping bags or other plastic film as mattress covers because they can cause suffocation.
- CAUTION: ANY MATTRESS USED IN THIS CRIB MUST BE AT LEAST 27-1/4 IN BY 51-5/8 IN (69CM X 131CM) WITH A THICKNESS THAT DOES NOT EXCEED 6 IN (15CM).






STEP 1:

- a. Insert 2 Wood Dowels (#6) into top rail of Left Side Panel (A).
- b. Attach Rear Left Leg (E) and Front Left Leg (G) to the Left Side Panel (A) by using 4 Bolts (#2).
- c. Repeat above steps to the Right Side Panel (B). Tighten firmly with Wrench (#7).



STEP 2:

Attach Rear Left Leg (E) and Rear Right Leg (F) on the side panels to the Headboard (D) by inserting 2 Wood Dowels (#6) on the top rail and 4 Barrel Nuts (#5) on the underside of each corner of the headboard before screwing 4 Bolts (#1) to secure the legs. Make sure when securing the bottom rail of the Headboard (D) to the legs to insert the bolts through the lower one of the 2 holes on the legs.



STEP 3


a. Attach Mattress Support (I) flat side up by swinging out the four hangers at the corners of the mattress support and use 4 Bolts (#3) to attach hangers to the brackets on the legs at an even level on all sides.






STEP 4

Attach Front Left Leg (G) and Front Right Leg (H) on the side panels to the Footboard (C) by inserting 2 Wood Dowel (#6) and 4 Barrel Nuts (#5) on the underside of each corner of the footboard before screwing 4 Bolts (#1) to secure the legs. Make sure when securing the bottom rail of the footboard to the legs to insert the bolts through the lower one of the 2 holes on the legs.



STEP 5:


a. Attach Stabilizer Bar (J) to the legs on the Left Side Panel (A) and Right Side Panel (B) with 2 Bolts (#1), 2 Barrel Nuts (#5) and 2 Wood Dowels (#6).


- a. Loosen the bolts from the Side Panels to the Footboard (C) bolts to detach the Footboard.

*Mattress Support Assembly must be in the lowest position before installing guardrail.


- a. Loosen the bolts from the Side Panels to the Footboard (C) bolts to detach the Footboard.
- b. Adjust Stabilizer Bar (J) by moving up one level to where the original Footboard was attached.
- c. Attach Guardrail (K) to Stabilizer Bar (J) by using 2 Bolts (#4), and Left Side Panel (A) by using 2 Bolts (#2).



H309 Full Size Bed Assembly Sheet

(Rails not included)

- *Metal frames can be purchased at any regular furniture store.
- a. Attach Headboard (D) to Rear Left Leg (E) and Rear Right Leg (F) as the headboard for the full size bed.
- b. Assemble the headboard by attaching the mattress support metal-frame rail to the bottom holes of the headboard.



- Parents should not use any crib with missing, broken or loose hardware parts. Crib slats or spindles should be spaced no more than 2-3/8" apart, and none should be loose or missing. NEVER use a crib with corner posts over 1/16" of an inch above the end panels (unless they are over 16" high for a canopy).
- Check this product for damaged hardware, loose joints, loose bolts or other fasteners, missing parts, or sharp edges before and after assembly and frequently during use. Securely tighten loose bolts and other fasteners. DO NOT use crib if any parts are missing, damaged or broken. Contact (AFG International Products Inc.) for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. DO NOT substitute parts.
- Never place infants to sleep on pillows, sofa cushions, adult beds, waterbeds, beanbags, or any other surface not specifically designed for infant sleep.
- Always check all sides and corners of the crib to assure proper assembly with no openings that may entrap a child. The crib mattress should fit snugly with no more than two fingers width, one-inch, between the edge of the mattress and the crib side. Otherwise, the baby can get trapped between the mattress and the side of the crib.
- Do not try to repair any side of the crib without manufacturer-approved hardware.
- Putting a broken side up against the wall is not a solution and can often make the situation worse.
- When re-assembling the crib for your second child, please keep in mind that the screw holes will need to be filled in order for the screws to grip to the wood. Talk to your local hardware store or lumberyard about how to do it properly.
